5	Whereas, in Crouse v. NW Georgia Presbytery (2019-03), the Standing Judicial Commission
6	declared that the sequence in <i>BCO</i> 24-1 is mandatory: there is a nomination period; all
7 8	nominees shall go through training; and then all nominees shall go through examination; and
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10	Whereas, only after examination would it be possible to remove nominees from the process:
11	and
12	
13	Whereas, the SJC further declared that if sessions desired more flexibility in the process, they
14	should submit an overture to the General Assembly seeking such; and
15	should sachite air overtare to the School Pissemory seeking sach, and
16	Whereas, this overture seeks to amend BCO 24-1 simply by adding a word and eliminating a
17	word; and
18	
19	Whereas, the word added, "qualified," keeps in place the general mandate of BCO 24-1.
20	represented by the "shall" statements, while granting sessions flexibility to remove
21	"clearly or grievously disqualified" nominees from the process apart from the
22	instruction and examination process; and
23	
24	Whereas, the word removed, "then," allows sessions to sequence their examinations as they
25	desire; and
26	
27	Whereas, some sessions may desire to do the examination for Christian experience first prior
28	to instruction; removing "then" would allow such to happen; and
29	
30	Whereas, the overture keeps the "shall" statements to ensure that all the parts of the
31	instruction and examination process remain in place for qualified nominees;
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33	Therefore, be it resolved that Book of Church Order 24-1 be amended as follows
34	(underlining for additions, strike through for deletions):
35	
36	24-1. Every church shall elect persons to the offices of ruling elder and
37	deacon in the following manner: At such times as determined by the
38	Session, communicant members of the congregation may submit names
39	to the Session, keeping in mind that each prospective officer should be
40	an active male member who meets the qualifications set forth in
41	1 Timothy 3 and Titus 1. After the close of the nomination period,
42	qualified nominees for the office of ruling elder and/or deacon shall
43	receive instruction in the qualifications and work of the office. Each
44	<u>qualified</u> nominee shall then be examined in:

1	a. his Christian experience, especially his personal character and family
2	management (based on the qualifications set out in 1 Timothy 3:1-7 and
3	Titus 1:6-9),
4	b. his knowledge of Bible content,
5	c. his knowledge of the system of doctrine, government, discipline contained
6	in the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church in America (BCO Preface III,
7	The Constitution Defined),
8	d. the duties of the office to which he has been nominated, and
9	e. his willingness to give assent to the questions required for ordination.(BCO
10	24-6)
11	
12	If there are candidates eligible for the election, the Session shall report to
13	the congregation those eligible, giving at least thirty (30) days prior notice of the
14	time and place of a congregational meeting for elections.
15	If one-fourth (1/4) of the persons entitled to vote shall at any time request
16	the Session to call a congregational meeting for the purpose of electing additional
17	officers, it shall be the duty of the Session to call such a meeting on the above
18	procedure. The number of officers to be elected shall be determined by the
19	congregation after hearing the Session's recommendation.
20	
21	
22	So that if adopted it would read:
