

PCA General Assembly Seminar Submission Guidelines

Goal and Purpose:

General Assembly Seminars were established for the purpose of edifying and encouraging General Assembly attendees in their faith and in their ministry. Seminar presenters are selected with a view to building up the body of Christ—addressing both topics of timeless relevance to the church and topics of particular contemporary relevance. Seminar speakers are expected to deliver presentations that are in accord with Scripture and the confessional standards of the PCA. Speakers are not to use seminars to sell services or to advocate for causes, and should not use seminars to promote particular positions on legislative matters currently before the Assembly.

Details:

- Seminar proposal submissions must be submitted using the google form provided.
- Seminar speakers will provide their **final** title, seminar description, and biographical information at the time of submission.
- Each seminar is 50 minutes long
- Each seminar speaker will work with a “room host” to ensure that seminars end on time and that the maximum occupancy of the room is not exceeded
- Seminar proposals must be submitted by January 31st
- Speakers will be contacted in March with a decision as to whether or not their seminar was chosen to be presented at General Assembly
