

1 **OVERTURE 9** from Calvary Presbytery (to CCB, OC)  
2 “Amend *BCO* 34-1 Establishing Percentage Threshold for Original Jurisdiction  
3 Requests”  
4

5 **Be it resolved** that *BCO* 34-1 be amended as follows (~~strike-through~~ for deletions,  
6 underlining for new wording):  
7

8 34 - *Special Rules Pertaining to Process Against a Minister (Teaching Elder)*  
9

10 34-1. Process against a minister shall be entered before the Presbytery of  
11 which he is a member. However, ~~if the Presbytery refuses to act in~~ doctrinal  
12 cases or cases of public scandal, if ~~two other~~ 10% of Presbyteries request  
13 the General Assembly to assume original jurisdiction (to first receive and  
14 initially hear and determine), the General Assembly shall do so.  
15

16 So that *BCO* 34-1 reads:  
17

18 34-1. Process against a minister shall be entered before the Presbytery of  
19 which he is a member. However, in doctrinal cases or cases of public  
20 scandal, if 10% of Presbyteries request the General Assembly to assume  
21 original jurisdiction (to first receive and initially hear and determine), the  
22 General Assembly shall do so.  
23

24 **Rationale:**

25 *BCO* 34-1 as currently written has long existed within the PCA as a constitutional variant. The  
26 meaning of the phrase “if the Presbytery refuses to act” has no clear definition and has made  
27 application of its usage ineffective.  
28

29 This overture seeks to do two things simultaneously: first it clearly defines the terms of  
30 General Assembly original jurisdiction of a presbytery while secondly making it the process  
31 more difficult to do so than the current threshold of 2 presbyteries. The standard of request  
32 will increase from 2 presbyteries to 10% of presbyteries.
