2	"Amend BCO 16 by Adding 16-4 Regarding Qualifications for Church Office"
3	
4	Whereas, our churches are under continual pressure to conform to the standards of the
5	world on sexuality, and Christians in our churches often use the language of the
6	world in minimizing or maximizing certain sin patterns, and
7	
8	Whereas, the documents of the PCA should, as much as possible, have a timeless character
9	that transcends the specific issues in one particular day, and
10	
11	Whereas, a previous overture on this topic was passed at General Assembly, and there is
12	wide support for the spirit of that overture, but substantial disagreement on the
13	precision of the language, as well as concern that it is overly connected to current
14	terminology of our society, and
15	
16	Whereas, there is widespread agreement on the language of the Report by the Ad Interim
17	Committee on Human Sexuality, and
18	
19	Whereas, the spirit of our Standards (e.g., WCF XV:4) is not to single out any category of
20	sin as especially separate from all other types of sin (such as homosexuality or
21	racism, in different eras) but to enjoin us to ongoing repentance of all types of sin,
22	and
23	
24	Whereas, there is substantial debate as to whether some officers in the PCA use
25	identification with certain categories of sin as a way of downplaying the need for a
26	complete and full sanctification in those areas, which must include repentance not
27	just from the outward practice of sins but also from the inward desire for those sins;
28	
29	Therefore be it resolved that a new paragraph 16-4 be added to BCO 16, which shall read
30	as follows:
31	
32	16-4 Officers in the Presbyterian Church in America must be above reproach in their
33	walk and Christlike in their character. Those who deny the sinfulness of fallen
34	desires, or who deny the reality and hope of progressive sanctification, or who fail to
35	pursue Spirit-empowered victory over their sinful temptations, inclinations, and
36	actions are not qualified for ordained office. Our standard of conduct is always the
37	Word of God, which transcends any culture; whether a sin is especially hated or
38	excused in a particular society shall neither excuse those who are unrepentant nor bar
39	those who are clearly repentant.
