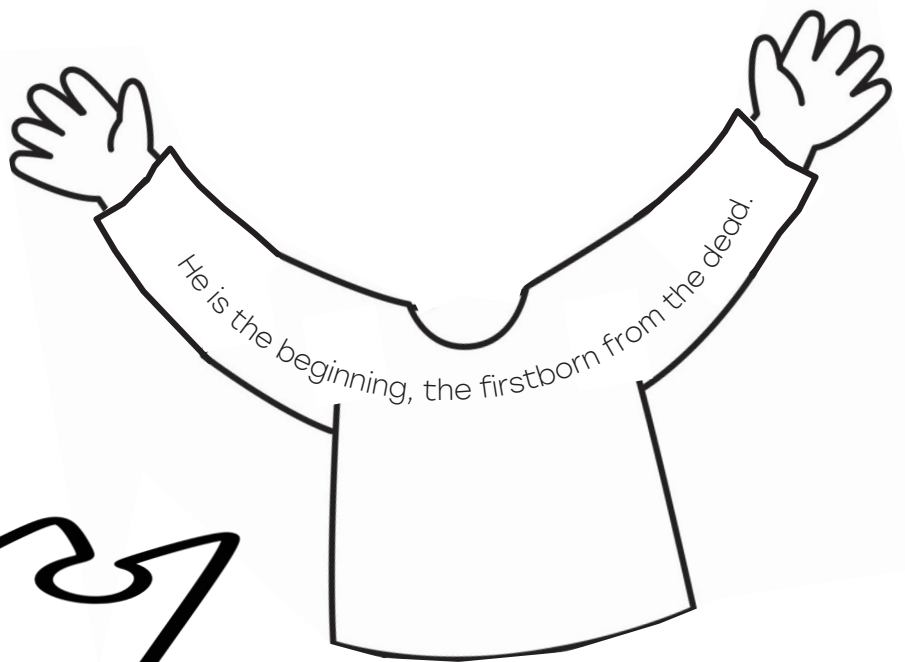
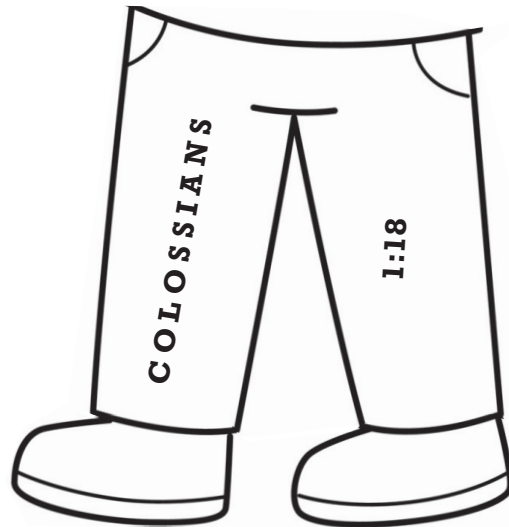
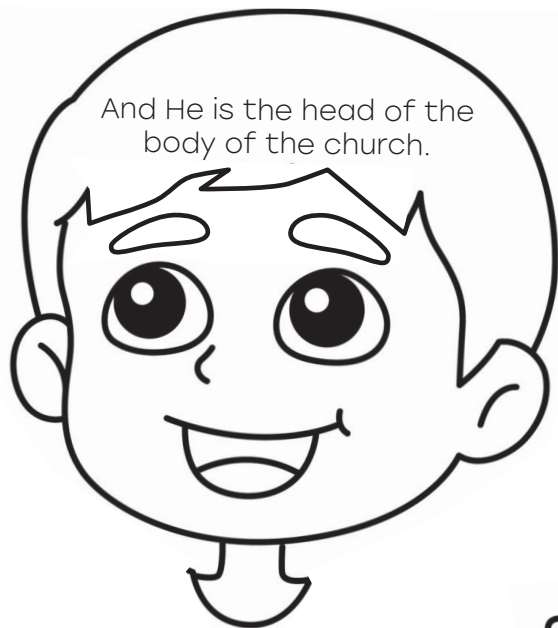
INSTRUCTIONS:

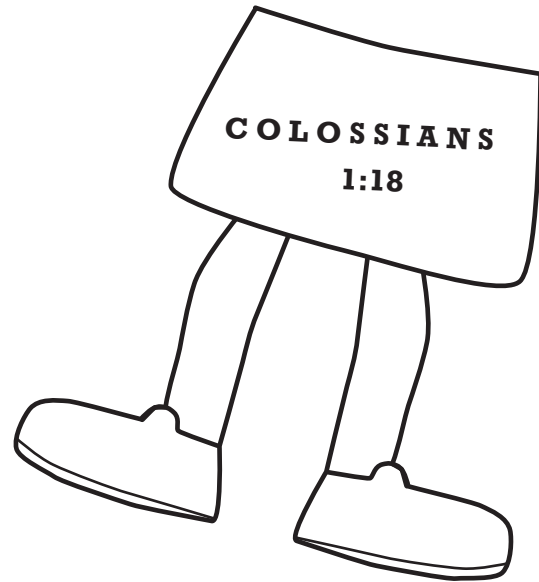




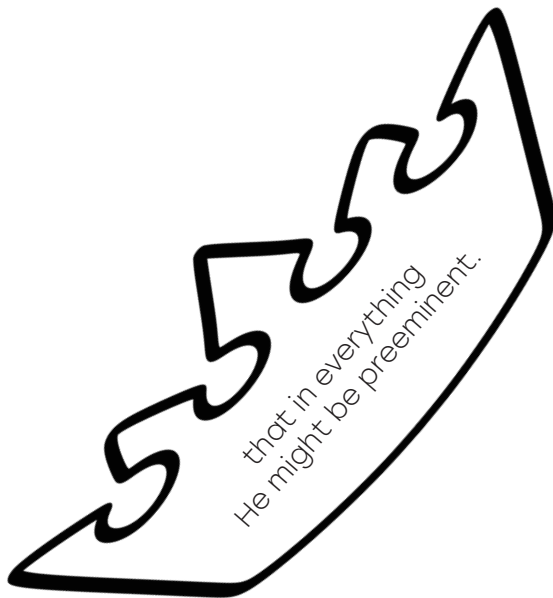
