19 20 21 22	Therefore, be it resolved that the General Assembly amend <i>BCO</i> 57-5 to revise our membership vows to include 2 addenda and one language update (<u>underlining</u> for additions; <u>strikethrough</u> for deletions):
23 24	Add an entire new first vow for membership and renumber the existing vows.
25 26 27	1. Do you agree that you are made in the image of God, designed by God to glorify God and enjoy Him forever?
28 29 30 31	Insert the words "both beloved and" into the former vow #1. 12. Do you acknowledge yourselves to be both beloved and sinners in the sight of God, justly deserving His displeasure, and without hope save in His sovereign mercy?
32 33 34 35 36	Change the word "study" to "promote" in the final vow. 56. Do you submit yourselves to the government and discipline of the Church, and promise to study promote its purity and peace?
37 38	So that the amended vows would read as follows:
39 40 41	 Do you agree that you are made in the image of God, designed by God to glorify God and enjoy Him forever? Do you acknowledge yourselves to be both beloved and sinners in the
