OVERTURE 43 from the Calvary Presbytery

"Amend RAO 4-11 regarding Data on Age and Ethnicity"

Whereas RAO 4-11 authorizes the Administrative Committee to collect statistical information

Whereas RAO 4-11 authorizes the Administrative Committee to collect statistical information for the purpose of providing and publishing "guidelines for the Partnership Share Giving Program of the PCA, including the Ministry Ask" and for no other stated reason; and,

Whereas *RAO* 4-11 specifies that said "guidelines shall include statistical information expressed both in per capita giving terms and in proportional (percentage) giving terms to demonstrate the giving necessary to attain full funding for budgets of the General Assembly Committees and Agencies" and nothing more; and,

Whereas the Office of the Stated Clerk, through a note contained in a box on the bottom of page 2 of the 2024 Annual Statistical Report Form, informed the congregations of the PCA that "two new line items" regarding "communicant member ethnicity and age" would appear "on the 2025 Annual Statistical Report Form" to be sent out for completion in 2026; and,

Whereas the practical difficulties of collecting information on "communicant member ethnicity and age" are greater than perhaps the Stated Clerk's Office has yet considered due to members' reticence to share their ages or uncertain of how best to categorize their ethnicity, with many of our members being the children of interracial/multiethnic unions; and,

Whereas the theological commitments of the PCA derived from Scripture and expressed in the PCA's subordinate Standards and Constitute militate against the collection of data pertaining to ethnicity, for the PCA confesses with Scripture that though our members come from many different backgrounds (ethnic and otherwise), our Triune God has united us together as "one body" (1 Cor. 12:12), with Christ Himself being "our peace, who made both groups into one and broke down the barrier of the dividing wall" (Eph. 2:14), baptizing all "by one Spirit...into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves of free," and making all "to drink of one Spirit" (1 Cor. 12:13), even while acknowledging that Old Testament historical narratives, ceremonial laws, and prophecies frequently refer to people groups by familial origin, tribal associations, ethnic affinities, nations, and what some commentators might refer to as racial distinctions, yet never in such a way so as to accept as appropriate the continuing use of such distinctions in the formal categorization of members of the church of Jesus Christ; and,

Whereas the kingdoms of this world may collect (and even act upon) certain demographic information, yet God has neither directed nor authorized the church to collect such information pertaining to ethnicity; and,

Whereas there are two classes of people with which the church should be concerned, in its formal statistical record-keeping: covenant-keepers and covenant-breakers (<i>BCO</i> 56-4.j.), recorded in the PCA as those who are in covenant with God through their own "profession of faith in Christ" (<i>BCO</i> 6-2; see also 57-3, 4) or "through the covenant and by right of birth" as "non-communing members of the church" (<i>BCO</i> 6-1), thus furnishing the church with two classes of those who are deemed in covenant with God—communing members and non-communing members (WCF 25.2; WLC 62)—and one additional record of those who break covenant with God and come under the censure of excommunication (<i>BCO</i> 30-1, 4); and,
Whereas there is no clear usefulness or theological justification for further subdividing either of these two categories (i.e., covenant-keepers and covenant-breakers) in terms of either age or ethnicity; and,
Whereas the collection of data pertaining to age or ethnicity gives the appearance of the sins of partiality (James 2:9) and pride, which must not be indulged even at the first stirring

Whereas the resolution of the conflict between Hellenistic Jews and native Hebrews in Acts 6 does not constitute an approved example that would lead us by necessary inference to collect denomination-wide demographic data pertaining to ethnicity or age; and,

recorded in 2 Samuel 24 and cited in 1 Chronicles 21; and,

of the same (James 1:14-15), as illustrated in King David's sinful (and deadly) census

Whereas the collection of demographic data pertaining to ethnicity or age is not necessary for the undershepherds called and ordained by Christ to know the flock in their care; and,

Whereas the church is called to "examine everything carefully; hold fast to that which is good; abstain from every form of evil" (1 Thess. 5:21-22).

Therefore, be it resolved that Calvary Presbytery hereby overtures the 52nd General Assembly to amend *RAO* 4-11 by adding the following to the third paragraph (underlining for additions):

Such statistical information shall not include data pertaining to age or ethnicity.

So that the amended section will read as follows:

4-11. The budget for each permanent Committee and Agency shall be submitted to the Administrative Committee of General Assembly, which shall independently evaluate the proposed budget of each permanent Committee and Agency and report to the Assembly its considered opinion on the adoption. To protect the ministry and fiduciary responsibilities of the Committees and Agency Boards, the financial coordination and independent evaluation of the

budgets by the Administrative Committee shall be for review, discussion, and recommendation to the Assembly.

Should modifications in budgets be deemed necessary by the Assembly, special care shall be taken that changes not be made in such a way as to threaten the continuity or effectiveness of the Committee's or Agency's ministry. Budgets of permanent Committees and Agencies that are agreed upon by the Administrative Committee may be changed only by a two-thirds vote of the Assembly commissioners present and voting at the time the budget is submitted for adoption. In the event the Administrative Committee disagrees with the budget submitted by one of the Committees or Boards, in whole or any item thereof, the General Assembly may adopt either the Committee's or Board's budget or the Administrative Committee's recommended budget by simple majority. The requirement of a two-thirds vote of the General Assembly applies only to changes not recommended by the Administrative Committee, initiated on the floor of the Assembly. With respect to the Committees and Agencies, financial coordination is through the Administrative Committee to the Assembly and from the General Assembly to the Committees and Agencies. The Administrative Committee is a "filter upward" and has no downward authority.

The Administrative Committee shall annually provide and publish guidelines for the Partnership Share Giving Program of the PCA, including the Ministry Ask. These guidelines shall include statistical information expressed both in per capita giving terms and in proportional (percentage) giving terms to demonstrate the giving necessary to attain full funding for budgets of the General Assembly Committees and Agencies. Such statistical information shall not include data pertaining to age or ethnicity.

The Committees and Agencies receiving support through the PCA Partnership Share Giving Program shall present their financial needs and their Ministry Ask to the Administrative Committee for review and recommendation in the course of the regular budgeting process. Each Committee and Agency shall then be free to request from the PCA churches and constituency the contributions necessary to fund its approved budget.

While all churches remain free to give their contributions as they by God's guidance determine, all churches are encouraged to give, as they are able, at least ten percent (10%) of their tithes and offerings to the PCA causes of presbyteries and General Assembly.

The Administrative Committee shall maintain a manual containing the Affirmation of Core Financial Standards. This information, by which each PCA General Assembly ministry (Committee or Agency) shall function and by
