13	Whereas, the Westminster Standards, as adopted by the Presbyterian Church in America and

15	substantial, biblical guidance concerning Christian citizenship and the relationship of

18	Whereas, an explication of principles may prove more helpful than a focus on persons or rapidly changing movements, and may be helpful to the church in decades to come,

20	Therefore, be it resolved that the 52 nd General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in
22	America direct its moderator to appoint an unfunded ad interim committee to produce
