(Level One is the Parking Garage\*)







## **Worship Speakers**



#### Jim Wert

Jim Wert is a Ruling Elder in the Metro Atlanta Presbytery (MAP). He grew up in western North Carolina and came to faith under the shepherding of TE John Neville, one of the early fathers of the PCA. A graduate of UNC-Chapel Hill, he moved to Atlanta in 1980, where he married Emily, now his bride of 36 years, started his business career, and joined the then nomadic Perimeter Church, where he served as a deacon. Committed urban Atlantans, the Wert family was among the core group that formed an early Perimeter plant, Intown Community Church. Jim has served there as an elder since 1992. He also

serves on MAP's credentials and church planting committees. A management consultant, Jim works with a global array of faith-based nonprofits in strategy and organizational design. The Werts have four adult children and have been known to wander New Zealand in search of Middle-earth film sites.



#### **Tim Keller**


Tim was raised in the Lehigh Valley of Pennsylvania and is a graduate of Bucknell University (B.A., 1972), Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary (M.Div., 1975), and Westminster Theological Seminary, where he received his D.Min in 1981. He served as a pastor in Hopewell, VA, for nine years, while also serving as the then Mid-Atlantic Presbytery's director of church planting. He was an associate professor of preaching on the faculty of Westminster Theological Seminary in Philadelphia from 1984 to 1989, while also serving as the Director of the Doctor of Ministry program.

Tim and his wife, Kathy, moved to New York City in 1989 to plant Redeemer Presbyterian Church, where he remains the senior pastor. He is the founder and Chairman of Redeemer City to City, which has helped start over 300 churches in global cities worldwide. He is the author of such New York Times bestselling books as *The Reason for God, The Prodigal God,* and *The Meaning of Marriage*.



#### **Kevin DeYoung**

Kevin DeYoung is the Senior Pastor at University Reformed Church (PCA) in East Lansing, Michigan, located near Michigan State University. He serves as a council member at The Gospel Coalition and blogs on TGC's *DeYoung, Restless and Reformed*. Kevin is Chancellor's Professor of Systematic and Historical Theology at Reformed Theological Seminary and a PhD candidate at the University of Leicester. He has authored several books, including *Just Do Something, The Hole in Our Holiness, Crazy Busy, Taking God At His Word,* and *The Biggest Story.* Kevin and his wife, Trisha, have six children.
