

Whether you are looking for a church, seeking to understand your own church experience better, or wanting to guide others in deepening the church's true identity, this book is for you.





### WELCOME FROM HOST COMMITTEE





So, do you need a fresh infusion of His love? Are you weary in well doing and seeking to serve others from your own resources and strength? Our prayer for this General Assembly is that you be refreshed and encouraged.
