

Welcome from the Host Committee

On behalf of the 2022 Host Committee, welcome to the Magic City for the 49th General Assembly. There are many things for which Birmingham is well known, and this rich history has shaped the community that we are today. Whether it was the boom of the steel industry or the struggles of the civil rights era, Birmingham has emerged as a city that is better because of our past. The city itself is an illustration of our theme “Purified to Proclaim” as it embraces the struggles of the past to provide for a better future.

While you are in our city, take some time to visit the historical sites and our Civil Rights Museum, where you can see firsthand the struggles encountered during that era. The history of the steel industry can be seen at Sloss Furnace and overlooking the city as a statue of Vulcan sits atop Red Mountain (for a PG-13 version, drive over the mountain and view the statue from the southern side). In the museum, you will learn of the blast furnace that was used to melt and purify the metal that shaped the city (and many others) that exist today.

When we first began planning for the 48th General Assembly in 2019, we landed on the theme of Purified to Proclaim. Little did we know how much purification was on the horizon. After our meeting in 2020 was canceled, we put everything on hold. All of us learned to



maneuver and manage in the face of a global pandemic, but through it all, God continued to purify and refine His people, even as the Furnaces here in our city refined those metals so important to its life. Our desire for you this week is for you to see how God has purified you, your church, and our denomination, and how the truth of 1 Peter 1:6-7 has made itself evident in your life (“In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials, so that the tested genuineness of your faith—more precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire—may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ.”).

Tuesday, June 21

Dr. L. Roy Taylor: L. Roy Taylor, born in Birmingham, Alabama, has been a minister of the Presbyterian Church in America since its inception in 1973 and has been a commissioner to every PCA General Assembly. Ordained at the first meeting of Evangelical Presbytery, he served as pastor of Rainbow Presbyterian Church in Gadsden, Alabama, for five years and pastor of the First Presbyterian Church of Hattiesburg, Mississippi, for eleven years. He served ten years on the faculty of Reformed Theological Seminary, Jackson, Mississippi, and served as Stated Clerk of the General Assembly of the PCA from 1998 to 2020. Dr. Taylor holds a Doctor of Ministry degree from Fuller Theological

Seminary, Pasadena, California. He and his wife of fifty-six years, Donna, live in South Carolina. They have a son, Timothy Taylor, and a daughter, Rebekah Whitmire, and nine grandchildren.

Rev. Kevin DeYoung: Kevin DeYoung is the senior pastor at Christ Covenant Church (PCA) in Matthews, North Carolina and Associate Professor of Systematic Theology at Reformed Theological Seminary (Charlotte). Prior to the summer of 2017, he pastored at University Reformed Church in East Lansing, Michigan (2004-2017). Kevin holds a Master of Divinity from Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary and received his Ph.D. in early modern history at the University of Leicester. He is the author of several books, including *The Biggest Story*, *The Hole in Our Holiness*, *Crazy Busy*, and *Just Do Something*. Kevin and his wife, Trisha, have nine children.



Thursday, June 23

Rev. Elbert McGowan, Jr.: Elbert McGowan is the Senior Pastor of Redeemer Church, PCA, an intentionally multiethnic community church located in the heart of Jackson, Mississippi. Raised in Jackson and touched by a crack cocaine epidemic and accompanying violence, he left Mississippi in 1996 to attend Alabama A&M University, where he earned a B.S. in Mechanical Engineering. While working for General Electric Aircraft Engines in Cincinnati, Ohio, Jesus rescued him. At about the same time family members at “home” were being saved by Christ, and his parents stumbled upon and joined a PCA church in Jackson (Trinity). In 2004, Elbert and his bride (Karen) felt God’s call back to Jackson.

Enrolling in RTS Jackson, he became a pastoral intern at Redeemer Church, a church plant under the leadership of Rev. Mike Campbell. In 2007, Elbert and Karen, both graduates of Historically Black Colleges & Universities (Alabama A&M, Stillman College, Florida A&M University) felt called to start an RUF ministry at another HBCU - Jackson State University. After serving as the RUF Campus Minister at JSU for 9 years, in 2016 he became the Senior Pastor of Redeemer. Elbert and his lovely wife of 18 years have two biological children, Karis (15) and Tripp (12), four others whom they hope to meet in glory, and hundreds of former students who continue to follow Jesus.
